2012-2013 saw Peter Paul's academic program expand beyond the walls of the Center with the addition of our after school program at Fairfield Court Elementary School. In the process, we grew the number of students served to 125, a 50% increase over last year. As always, of more importance than the quantity of children served is the quality of our students' achievements. The opportunities and experiences illustrated on pages 4-8 demonstrate that Peter Paul students continue to be prepared with the foundation of a successful future.

Programs delivered through partnership with other best-in-class organizations enhanced services to Senior Citizens and addressed the critical needs of hundreds of community residents. In addition, Peter Paul cultivated and nurtured an array of in-kind relationships with area businesses, faith-based institutions and universities.

Alongside the continued growth and strength of our programs, we maintained a focus on organizational excellence. Fundraising, always an indicator of the community's faith in an organization, rose to record levels. Refining the delivery of our model kept expenses nearly level with the previous year, ensuring that we ended the year in a sound financial position.

## PPDC@FCES

During the 2012-2013 academic year, PPDC embarked on a new venture – a pilot after school program at nearby Fairfield Court Elementary School (PPDC@FCES)!

PPDC@FCES began with gusto on November 14, 2012, and continued through May 23, 2013. The 44 program participants in grades 2-5 followed the same model utilized at PPDC. Students were tested at the beginning of the program and a Peter Paul Education Plan (P-PEP) was created to guide instruction; a post-test was administered at the end of the program. Richmond Public Schools (RPS) provided transportation for the students; the day lasted from 3:15 – 5:30 p.m., Monday through Thursday.

The weekly schedule included Discovery Learning on Mondays, Writing Workshop or Enrichment on Tuesdays, Learning through Literature or Enrichment on Wednesdays, and S.T.E.A.M. (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics) on Thursdays. Daily, the students ate and had homework time from 3:15-3:45 p.m., recess from 3:45-4:00 p.m., and academic or enrichment time from 4:00-5:30 p.m.



Highlights from PPDC@FCES special events included two successful Parent Nights, a Holiday Celebration Dinner (provided by two members of St. James's), a Black History Celebration Program for a full house of parents, and a capstone field trip to an Education Day at Kings Dominion!

The program would not have been possible without the generous support from the Jessie Ball duPont Fund (via St. James's Episcopal Church), The Community Foundation Serving Richmond and Central Virginia, and the McKissick Family Foundation. In addition, the deep partnerships from other organizations made the program possible. These partners include Challenge Discovery, Communities In School of Richmond, Richmond Public Schools, St. James's Episcopal Church, and St. Stephen's Episcopal Church.

## Parent Survey

Parents of the students completed a survey at the conclusion of the 2012-2013 academic year. Results from the survey were extremely positive, with 50% of parents rating the overall program as excellent and 50% of parents rating the overall program as good. Additional results included:

- My child enjoys attending the after school program
  - 83% rated Strongly Agree
  - 17% rated Agree
- My child has a better attitude toward school
  - 67% rated Strongly Agree
  - 33% rated Agree
- My child seems happier or less stressed since participating in the after school program
  - 67% rated Strongly Agree
  - 33% rated Agree

## Our Mission

**Our mission is to build a community of learners by engaging and challenging children, families and seniors in Richmond's East End through programs that enhance academic achievement, provide cultural enrichment and promote self-esteem and lifelong self-sufficiency.**





## Youth Program

PPDC's Youth Program served 76 students in the After School Learning Immersion Program at PPDC and 57 students in the 2012 Summer Institute. (An additional 44 students participated in the PPDC @FCES program.) The Youth Program strives to serve all students in a holistic approach that will truly move the needle in high school graduation rates. All PPDC students achieved grade promotion at the end of the school year.

- **Nationally Standardized Test and P-PEP:** each student is tested at the beginning of the year utilizing a nationally standardized test that demonstrates to the teacher the strengths and weaknesses of each child in reading and math. The results from this test are translated into an individualized education plan (called a Peter Paul Education Plan or P-PEP), which charts the instructional needs for that student for the year.
- **Instruction Time:** while at PPDC each student averages 5 ½ hours of direct academic instruction per week; in addition, students spend an average of 3 ½ hours per week in enrichment activities. Some enrichment activities also include academic pieces and facilitate learning through experience or application.
- **Classroom Ratios:** each classroom of no more than 14 students has one certified or experienced teacher and one teacher's assistant. All instructional employees must have experience in youth development.
- **Volunteers:** PPDC utilizes volunteers as mentors, tutors, classroom assistants, and for project support. Volunteers are able to work one-on-one with students with lesson plans designed from the P-PEP designed to work on the student's individual academic needs.
- **Behavior:** each PPDC student is expected to behave appropriately while at the Center, school, or in the community. Each classroom at PPDC displays a set of behavior rules so that students understand their expectations. In addition, a behavioral chart in each classroom indicates to the student how their performance is for the day. Teachers send a daily behavior chart to the student's parent every evening; students must return the signed chart to PPDC the next day.
- **Attendance:** PPDC requires daily attendance of every student. In order for the academic plans to work, students must be engaged every day in the Youth Program.
- **Food:** PPDC is located in a food desert; and the majority of its students participate in the free and reduced lunch program at their. PPDC serves a full meal each day after school and a full lunch during Summer Institute (plus snacks) in order to ensure that students receive proper nutrition and are ready to learn.
- **Transportation:** a key component to the safety and attendance reliability of PPDC students is transportation. PPDC provides transportation from school (or home during the summer) to PPDC and then to individual homes every evening.

## Youth Program

Throughout the 2012-2013 academic year, PPDC students shined. A few examples of fun, hands-on projects included:

- **Egg Drop Contest** – to start the school year, all PPDC students participated in an egg drop contest; each class designed their own contraption to protect a raw egg as it was dropped from various heights on a ladder; prizes were awarded for best design, most creative, and overall best contraption
- **The Watercraft Challenge** – an engineering rally placing all students in teams to design, test, evaluate, and redesign a boat that could hold 25 pennies for at least 10 seconds before sinking using specified materials
- **Mock Election** – a Center-wide program with students presenting seven political issues; each class set up a booth for all of the PPDC students to vote on the issues
- **The December Club Showcase** featuring Fall clubs – step team, garden club video, fashion, sports, and cooking
- **Christmas Angel Program & Celebrations** – all PPDC and PPDC@FCES students plus their siblings were adopted by generous donors for the holidays; celebrations were coordinated for the PPDC students to celebrate the holidays with activities, food, and Santa Claus
- **College Tours** – the high school students participated in two college tours, visiting Randolph-Macon College, University of Richmond, Virginia Union University, and James Madison University
- **Career Shadowing Experiences, Service Learning Opportunities for Middle School Students** – students visited a law firm, acoustical engineering office, hair salon, and automobile mechanic
- **2nd Annual Cultural Review** – in May, PPDC students showcased what they had learned during the year with a performance for parents, volunteers, and fellow students demonstrating praise dance, cheerleading, girl scouts, drum line, and video clubs

A number of PPDC partners facilitated enrichment opportunities for the students during the 2012-2013 fiscal year. These experiences aided the students to participate in new programs, broaden their horizons as well as develop their own gifts and talents. PPDC partners included Bon Secours, Challenge Discovery, First Tee, First Things First, Junior League of Richmond, Police Athletic League, the School of the Performing Arts in the Richmond Community (SPARC), and ShrineMont.



## Looking Forward

PPDC is achieving significant growth in its programs, particularly as students are aging and wish to stay at PPDC. The middle school program had fourteen students during the 2012-2013 academic year and expects to double this number for the 2013-2014 academic year as the 5th graders graduate to 6th grade. Because of the significant growth, PPDC has revamped its middle and high school programs to accommodate the needs for that age of student. The middle school program incorporates career and college introductions; the high school program helps students prepare for post-high school graduation success.

During the 2012-2013 academic year, PPDC faced challenges with the nationally standardized testing tool, the Woodcock-Johnson III. The length of time it takes to test all of the students (testing is all one-on-one with a trained tester, testing takes at least one hour per student to complete), create the P-PEPs, and compile the information to present it to the classroom teacher meant that testing was taking too much of the valuable time needed to move the students forward academically. In addition, PPDC found that since the testing is administered individually, that the test could be subjective. To answer these challenges, PPDC will move forward during the 2013 summer program and 2013-2014 academic year with a new testing tool, the Northwest Evaluation Association's Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) test. Similar to the Woodcock-Johnson, MAP is also a nationally standardized test; it is aligned with Common Core Standards. It is a computer-based adaptive test, meaning that the test questions become easier or harder depending on whether or not students answer the questions correctly. In addition, because it is computer-based, an entire classroom can be tested at the same time and test results are delivered immediately. We look forward to implementing this new tool!

## Community Programs

- **Food Distribution** – PPDC remains an active partner with FeedMore, serving as its largest food distribution point in Richmond's East End. The program, which had been monthly for the majority of the 2012-2013 fiscal year, moved to twice per month in June. Several volunteer groups assisted with food distribution, including the Episcopal Diocese of Virginia, First Presbyterian Church, St. Peter's Episcopal Church, VCU's ASPIRE program, and VibrAlign. In addition to the food distribution program, PPDC also offers emergency food for community members in need; a marked increase in emergency food distribution occurred beginning in spring. During the 2012-2013 fiscal year, 4,400 total cumulative individuals were served through the distribution program (to note, some individuals would have participated in the program multiple times).
- **Senior Citizens** – this fiscal year, PPDC embarked on a new partnership with the Senior Center of Greater Richmond. The Senior Center of Greater Richmond facilitated all programming, while PPDC continued to offer the transportation, food, and location for the senior citizens. Through the Senior Center's programming, activities expanded to include basic health monitoring and chair exercises, while keeping in place the guest speakers, field trips, and social activities to which the senior citizens have been accustomed. In February, the senior citizens presented their own talent show with acts ranging from poetry to singing to playing the trombone! The senior citizens even began utilizing the computer lab (a brand new computer lab at PPDC was made possible through a grant from the Windsor Foundation Trust) learning to set up their own email addresses and use the internet!
- **Meals** – PPDC serves a number of meals throughout the year – to the students from Church Hill Academy (who operate out of PPDC during the school day), the PPDC students who attend the Youth Program, and the senior citizens. Last year alone, PPDC served nearly 18,000 meals!
- **Other Assistance** – Numerous individuals and organizations provide much needed services and goods for our students, families, and senior citizens including A.C.T.S. (Area Congregations Together in Service), Big Brothers Big Sisters, PPDC Children's Garden Coordinators Rick McCormick and Bob Siegfried, and Shalom Farms.

## 2012-2013 Volunteers and Gifts in Kind

Thank you to all of our 2012-2013 volunteers! Nearly 600 volunteers provided 5,676 hours of service, which is equivalent to \$125,667.

Our volunteers come from every part of town: from schools, churches, corporations, community partners, and individually. They are diverse in age, race, income, and talents, but they all share a commitment to a better future for Richmond's East End. The true measure of our volunteers lies in the spirit they bring to PPDC. It is the spirit of hope, and it is the spirit that breathes life into every program we offer.

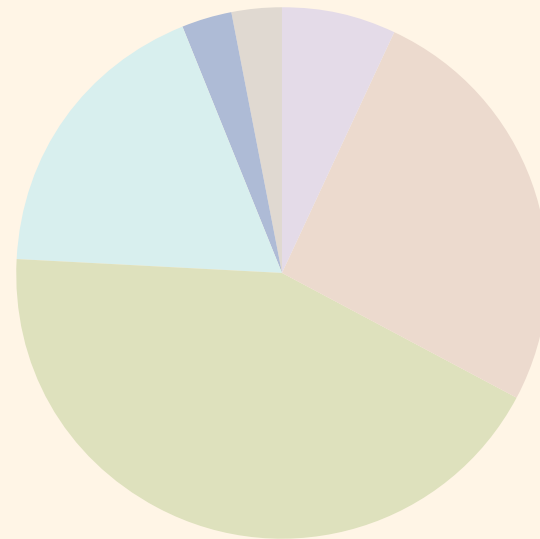
