Our Summer Promise program was filled with hands-on activities, wonderful learning opportunities, and unique experiences that students will be talking about all school-year.

Participants boosted their academic skills with the *Engineering is Elementary* and *Engineering Everywhere* curricula. Classes explored the mechanics of bubbles, designed and created structures, and explored green engineering by creating insulated homes.

Children learned the benefits of healthy eating and nutrition with the Organwise Guys program through the Virginia Cooperative Extension. PPDC's annual Clare's Camp exposed children to various cultures from around the world through guest speakers, arts and crafts, and games.
