# KaBOOM!: That's a Wrap

Building a playground is no small feat! Through the magic of great planning, volunteer power, and some serious elbow grease, Peter Paul and 200+ volunteers managed to build a play space in just one day!

Because of an incredible partnership with KaBOOM! and The CarMax Foundation, Peter Paul now has a wonderful



playground next to our Center at 1708 N. 22<sup>nd</sup> Street. Leading up to Build Day, weekly planning calls with KaBOOM!, CarMax, and Peter Paul parents, staff, and volunteers ensured that all of the critical elements for the big day were thought out and in place. We are also most grateful to the incredibly skilled group of volunteers who came out to put their skills to use for a "Prep Day" the Tuesday before Build Day, which also set the stage for success.

On Thursday, June 7, more than 200 volunteers from our community and CarMax joined us bright and early! The army of helpers was broken up into teams, each tasked with different projects ranging from assembling the playground to building a giant Jenga set. The teams worked so hard that they finished ahead of schedule!

In just five hours:

- 200+ volunteers gathered and organized into teams
- 137 cubic yards of mulch was shoveled and spread
- 3 pallets of 80 lb bags of cement were mixed, hauled, and put in place
- An INCREDIBLE playground was built!



We are so amazed by the outcome of this project! Our playground is beautiful and our students are thrilled to have a new safe space to play (the smile in the picture to the left says it all!). We are most grateful to all of the individuals, businesses, and groups for the part they played - volunteering to build, donating in-kind supplies and food, serving on the planning committee, and to our students and parents who dreamed of this beautiful play space!
