COVID-19 Updates

We've sent several updates about how Peter Paul is responding to COVID-19, but please see below for highlights of our programming and operational changes:

- Weekly staff check-in calls with students and families
- <u>Virtual enrichment lessons</u> focused on yoga, mindfulness/meditation, dance and step, STEM, and art
- <u>Weekly virtual hangouts</u> for parents and caregivers
- Regular communication and resource dissemination through our Promise Family Network Facebook group
- Community Action Network (CAN) meetings with local organizations to create more virtual engagement opportunities for families
- Community food distribution every first and third Wednesday in partnership with St. Peter's Episcopal Church and FeedMore
- Grocery drop-off to our seniors, and a weekly check-in with our partners at the Senior Center of Greater Richmond to assess needs
