Looking forward to what the future holds for Peter Paul and our community is critical, and no more so than in this current moment. With spring in the air and the sense of a new beginning on the horizon after such a long and challenging year, we are filled with hope and excitement as we think to the future for Peter Paul. We ask for your partnership in this next phase of service to the East End, which includes the following important components:

- We are thrilled to share that over the course of April and May we have been hosting a
 series of COVID-19 vaccine clinics at our Coleman Center. By helping the Richmond City
 Health District extend its reach into the East End and providing our community members
 with information, resources, and an accessible spot to get vaccinated, we are even more
 confident about resuming in-person activities this summer and fall.
- Peter Paul's <u>Summer Promise Academy</u> begins on July 6th at the Coleman Center and we cannot wait to welcome our students back in person! We will serve approximately 70 students to maintain a COVID-safe ratio, with a focus on academic remediation, recovery, and enrichment.
- Starting in the fall, three out of five Promise Centers will open in-person; expanded
 operations will depend upon updated health and safety protocols, enrollment, and
 demand.
- The family and community engagement team will begin offering a hybrid of in-person and virtual programs, with advocacy and community voice at the forefront as programming continues to develop.

We know that the last year has been challenging in all communities and in all families, regardless of circumstances, and we are incredibly grateful that you have faithfully supported this community. We could not respond to the call of our neighbors without people like you, and we humbly ask for your continued support as we confront the new and unique challenges to come.
