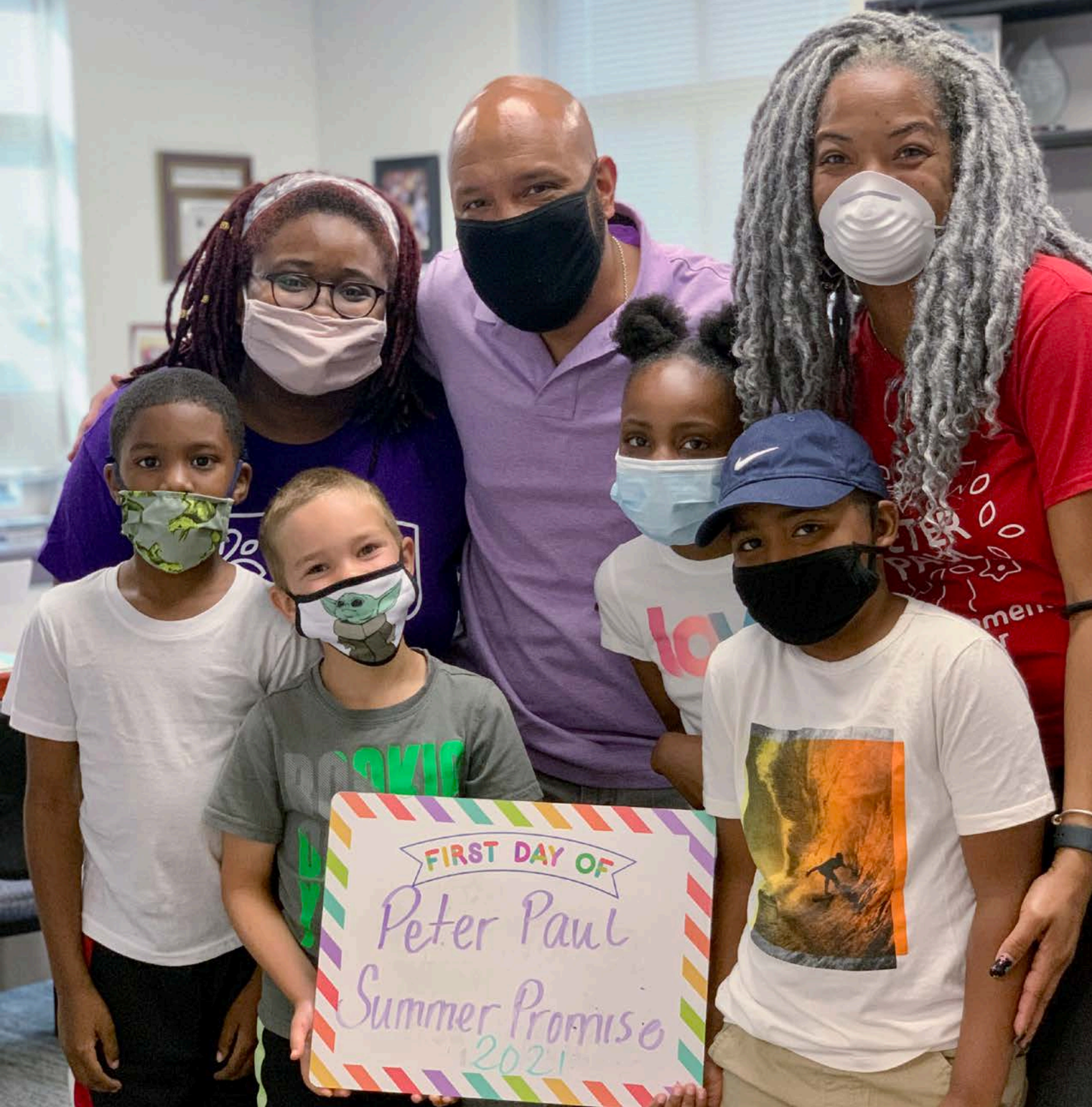

### VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT **Boxwood Garden Club**

In 2018, the Boxwood Garden Club started its partnership with Peter Paul with the goal of creating a garden and green space in the playground area adjacent to the Coleman Center. Boxwood Club member and nationally known landscape architect, Anna Aquino, helped develop the master plan for the space and secure contractors for the project. The 2019 Commonwealth Award grant from the Garden Club of Virginia helped give Boxwood Garden Club the resources to transform Peter Paul's playground into an inviting tree-filled native plant space that can be used as an educational space and gathering place for the neighborhood children and their families. Over the last two years, volunteers from the Club and their partners continued to plant, water, weed and mulch. One silver lining of the pandemic is that over the last year and a half, the garden has bloomed and matured, and is ready to continue to inspire the community.

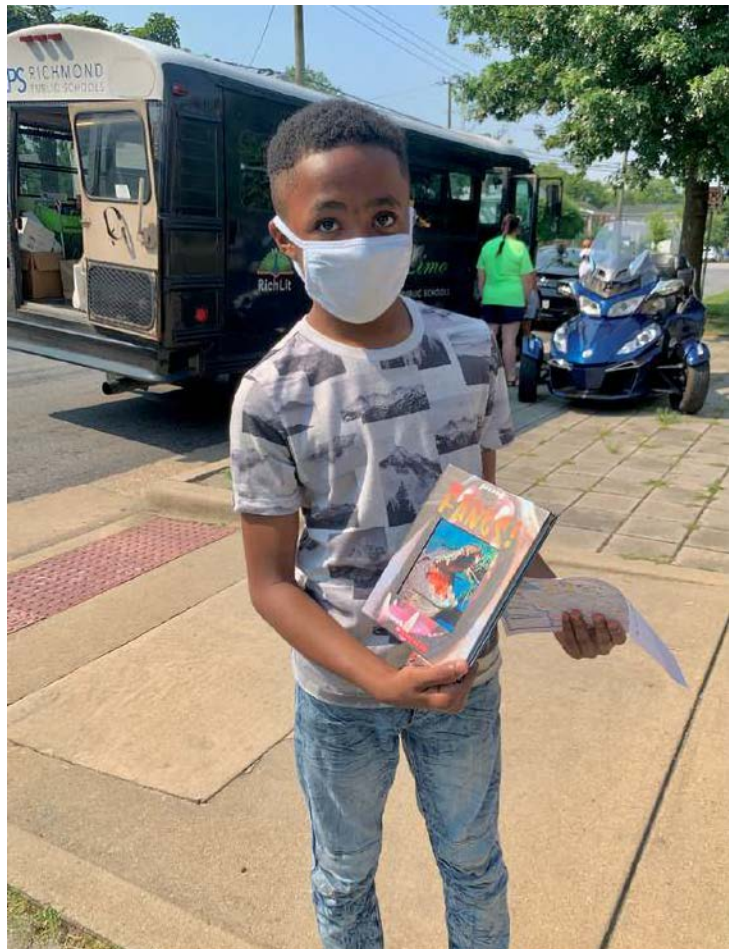
## WE ARE GRATEFUL FOR OUR Community Partners
