Programs and Services	Overview: (current function and structure)	Highlights:
Promise Academies	Peter Paul continues to partner with RPS to serve as the anchor partner for the five elementary schools in the City's east end. RPS provides the academic intervention and Peter Paul provides the SEL lessons, academic enrichment experiences, and family and community engagement programs. The Coleman Center operates independently from RPS to serve middle and high school students who attend Martin Luther King, Jr. Middle School, Franklin Military School, Binford Middle School, and one student who attends an independent school.	 The Coleman Center partners with Mr. Rick who provides bi-weekly garden lesson. Maggie Walker Regional School's students provide weekly virtual lessons on Financial Matters. Z-Life Coordinator adapts the program to include lessons and experiences for middle and high school students. Currently, Peter Paul is exploring opportunities to partner with VCU-Mary and Frances Youth Center, Robinson Community Center, TEEN Project, CodeVA, Richmond Cycling Corps, and RBHA. Peter Paul is Identifying former students who are not attending RPS Extended Day Program. If there are significant numbers of elementary students not involved in OST programs, Coleman Center will develop a program for them to begin mid-January. RPS has limited ability to provide transportation for students who attend their Extended Day Program.

	Peter Paul provides transportation for 45 students who attend all the sites. Peter Paul's transportation picks up students from three schools and one hub stop and brings them to the Coleman Center. We take home 18 students, providing door-to-door service.
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
